



BMW factory tour





#### **Student Residences**

Wavy Gate is our year-round purpose-built premium residence featuring spacious, single, en suite bedrooms in a contemporary building. There are on-site kitchen and laundry facilities, plus full time live-in wardens. A limited number of individual private "studio" apartments are also available. Wavy Gate is located in the vibrant student area of Cowley and is 15 minutes on foot (or less than ten minutes by bicycle) from St. Josephs Campus, and 25 minutes on foot from St. Michaels Campus — and from the city centre. We also offer a summer residence at Crescent Hall, a student residence which is part of Oxford Brookes University.

#### **Student Houses**

Kings Oxford's student houses are located in Wyville Court, just off a main road close to the city centre of Oxford; the ideal location makes for a pleasant 20 minute walk or 5 minute bus ride to our St Michaels campus.

Predominately for EFL Students, all rooms are single with shared bathrooms, 4-5 in a flat with 2 bathrooms. The building only offers self-catering with each flat equipped with a kitchen and communal meeting area plus an outside area for BBQ's in the summer months.

#### **Homestay**

Homestay is a great way to experience multi-cultural Britain and feel part of UK home life. We have a range of homestay hosts in Oxford (retired people, professional couples, single parents and families) who would all like to welcome you into their home. As a new member of the home you will take part in the normal routine of life. You will probably meet other members of the household, as well as friends and neighbours. This will be a good chance to practise your English. Every homestay is carefully inspected by our accommodation team and checked on a regular basis to ensure they exceed the minimum requirements of our students.
